CENTERVILLE, S.D. — Mrs. Anna Jensen, 91, died Saturday at Rock Island, Ill.

Anna Nielsen was born on April 14, 1888, in Copenhagen, Denmark. She moved to Chicago, Ill., in 1914, and graduated from the Baptist Missionary Training School in Chicago. She married Rev. John Jensen on Sept. 30, 1918, in Beresford, S.D. The couple served at the First Baptist Church in Centerville during the 1930s and 1940s. Her husband died in June, 1960, and for the past 17 years she has lived with her niece, Mrs. Warren Wakeland, in Rock Island.

Survivors include nieces and nephews.

Services will be at 10 a.m. Thursday at the Centerville Baptist Church. Wass Funeral Home is handling arrangements.

Anna L. Jensen, 91, of 4052 26th Ave., Rock Island, died Saturday afternoon at the Oak Glen Home in Coal Valley.

Visitation will be 7 to 9 p.m. Monday at Hodgson Funeral Home, Rock Island, and the body will be transferred to the Wass

Funeral Home in Centerville, S.D., for services and burial.

Born Anna Nielsen on April 14, 1888 in Copenhagen, Denmark, she immigrated to the U.S. in 1914. She was graduated from the Baptist Missionary Training School in Chicago.

She married the Rev. John Jensen on Sept. 30, 1918 in Beresford, S.D. Rev. Jensen was the pastor of the First Baptist Church at Centerville, S.D. for many years.

Mrs. Jensen was a member of the First Baptist Church in Rock Island.

Survivors include two neices, Mrs. Warren (Lorraine) Wakeland of Rock Island and Mrs. Jo-Ann Maere of Moline; and two nephews, Howard Nielsen of Lomita, Calif. and Robert Nielsen of New Jersey.
